

CANDLE HOLDER

Required Materials

- ♻️ Small baby food jar



- ♻️ Mod Podge® or white glue (mixed with water)



or

- ♻️ recycled tissue paper You can choose a specific color if you are making your candle holder for a holiday (i.e. Orange & Black – Halloween, Red & Pink – Valentine’s Day, etc.)



- ♻️ paint brush



- ♻️ votive candle



Step-By-Step Procedures

1. If you are using white glue, you will need to thin it first: mix equal parts of glue and water.
2. Paint a coating of Mod Podge® or the glue mixture on the baby food jar.
3. Place cut or ripped tissue paper in the desired pattern on the baby food jar.
4. Paint another coat of Mod Podge® or glue mixture. You can put the second layer of Mod Podge® or glue mixture on the tissue paper as you go along.
5. Let dry completely.
6. Add votive candle and enjoy.
7. You may also have to add rice to the bottom of the food jar so the candle is raised a little higher when placed in the candle holder. This depends on what size baby food jar you are using.



Note: You can also add ribbon or other desired decorations to your candle holder.
