

PLASTIC GROCERY BAG FLOWER

Required Materials

- ♻️ plastic grocery bags (various colors)
- ♻️ chenille (pipe cleaners)
- ♻️ scissors
- ♻️ drinking straw
- ♻️ craft glue

Step-By-Step Procedures

1. Cut 3 – 4 different sized circles from the bags: one 4-inch circle, one 3-inch circle and one or two 2-inch circles.
2. Layer the circles (centers aligned) in the following order from bottom to top: small, large, medium, small (if 4 are used).
3. Push chenille (pipe cleaners) through the centers of the circles until 2 ½ inches are sticking out of the top.
4. Grasp the plastic and chenille from the bottom and twist.
5. Add a drop of glue to the twist and insert chenille and twist into the end of the straw. If it is a bendable straw, bend the straw to keep the chenille in place.
6. Bend the top portion of chenille inside the flower to form the middle part of the flower that sticks out called the 'stamen'.
7. Fluff the bag circles to form the petals of the flower.
8. Put flowers in a vase and enjoy.
