

MAGAZINE ANGEL

Required Materials

- ✿ Reader's Digest (or similar sized magazine or catalog)
- ✿ craft glue
- ✿ spray paint
- ✿ skewer or small dowel rod
- ✿ Styrofoam ball
- ✿ something to make the hands out of: foam shapes, paper, felt
- ✿ **hair**: wool, raffia, curly hair for dolls, etc.
- ✿ **eyes**: foam cutouts, wiggly eyes, buttons, felt, etc.
- ✿ **nose**: felt, paper, foam cutouts, etc.
- ✿ **mouth**: felt, paper, foam cutouts, etc.
- ✿ **neck**: (optional) a gathering of lace to hide the Styrofoam ball and stick at the top of the book
- ✿ various trimmings
- ✿ Scissors



Step-By-Step Procedures

1. Take the magazine or catalog and open it up to the first page.
2. Take the upper right corner of a page, fold it down into the middle--towards the inside seam of the catalog--so that there is a straight edge from the inside edge of the top of the page to the middle of the page and it looks like a triangle.
3. Take the side of the page and fold it in towards the middle of the book--you should now have two folds on one page, keep the fold creased well. Continue this until all the pages are folded like above.
4. Glue the front and back pages together to form and cone shape and the angel stands up. This is the body.
5. Spray paint the body any color you want and let dry one day.
6. Put a skewer or thin dowel rod into the Styrofoam ball and glue on the end and push it into the center of the book.
7. Add hands, eyes, nose, mouth, hair and any trims you want to make to your angel.
8. You can make the angel into a choir girl/boy by adding a song book.
