

NEWSPAPER GIFT WRAP

Many types of wrapping paper are not recyclable. Instead of using these, try creatively wrapping presents in newspaper instead. The paper is recyclable and you can be as creative as you like.

Required Materials

- ♻️ old newspaper
- ♻️ tape
- ♻️ scissors
- ♻️ colored paper (try using scraps of paper that you have leftover from another project or craft instead of using new paper)

Step-By-Step Procedures

1. Trim a sheet of newspaper to the size you need to wrap the present.
2. Wrap the present as you would with wrapping paper.
3. Cut out a comic strip to go on top of the package (think of who the present is going to and what comic they would enjoy the most).
4. Cut a piece of colored paper slightly larger than the comic (this will be the border to highlight the comic strip). Tape the comic on top of the colored paper.
5. Tape the comic and colored paper to the top of the present.
6. *Optional:* Use the colored paper to make a name tag.
7. *Optional:* You could also create a newspaper bow/ribbon by shredding some newspaper and tying or gluing it to the top of the present.
