

POP BOTTLE CANDELHOLDERS

Required Materials

- ♻️ 2-liter pop bottle
- ♻️ sharp scissors
- ♻️ hole punch
- ♻️ Mod Podge® or white glue (mixed with water)
- ♻️ paint brush
- ♻️ tissue paper
- ♻️ thin ribbon
- ♻️ stickers

Step-By-Step Procedures

1. Cut the 2-liter pop bottle in half.
2. Trim the top of the bottle (end with pour spout) around the ring (about 4.5 inches from the top). Set aside.
3. Do the same with the remaining bottom half of the bottle. Trim around the ring; make sure the edges are smooth.
4. If you are deco paging either plastic parts, follow these directions:
 - a) Paint a coating of Mod Podge® or the glue mixture on the bottle part(s).
 - b) Place cut or ripped tissue paper in the desired pattern on the bottle part(s).
 - c) Paint another coat of Mod Podge® or glue mixture. You can put the second layer of Mod Podge® or glue mixture on the tissue paper as you go along.
 - d) Let dry completely.
5. Instead of deco paging, you can also use stickers.
6. Punch 5 – 7 holes along the brim of the bottom half of the plastic bottle. Run a piece of ribbon through the holes and tie at the end. Use scissors to curl the end of the ribbon. You now have a votive candle holder.
7. Wrap ribbon around the pour spout. Use scissors to curl the end of the ribbon. You now have a candle stick holder.
