

# TIN CAN PENCIL HOLDER

## Required Materials

- ♻️ one empty tin food can (remove label and file down any sharp edges on the cans)



- ♻️ recycled tissue paper



- ♻️ Mod Podge® or white glue (mixed with water)

- ♻️ paint brush



## Optional Materials

- ♻️ photograph
- ♻️ glitter
- ♻️ stickers
- ♻️ any other decorations you would like to use for your tin cans

## Step-By-Step Procedures

1. If you are using white glue, you will need to thin it first: mix equal parts of glue and water.
2. Paint a coating of Mod Podge® or the glue mixture on the tin can.
3. Place cut or ripped tissue paper in the desired pattern on the tin can.
4. Paint another coat of Mod Podge® or glue mixture. You can put the second layer of Mod Podge® or glue mixture on the tissue paper as you go along.
5. Let dry completely.
6. **Optional** – You can also glue a photograph on to the tin can after the layer of tissue paper is dry. You can even add glitter, stickers or any other decorations that you desire.
